- Maturity readiness for university study
- Ability attainment, general skills
- Commitment dedication, reliability, suitability
- Knowledge awareness of and familiarity with subject area

Can form basis of an interview

 Teachers will write your reference and submit it electronically to your Pupil Support Leader










