October Holiday and Start of the School Day

I am writing to give you information about the October holiday and an update about the arrangements for the start of the school day.

Firstly, I would like to remind you that the school closes for the October holiday on Friday 15 October at 12.20pm. We will reopen to pupils for the start of the new term on Tuesday 26 October.

When we return after the October holiday, we will revert back to **all** pupils in S1 to S6 having Tutor in the morning which means that all pupils will start school at the same time. This means that the first bell will sound at 8.25am and all pupils should make their way to their Tutor group which will start at 8.30am. The timings for the remainder of the day will not change.
