Early School Closure – Tuesday 13 September

I am writing to provide information about the early school closure on Tuesday 13 September.

The City of Edinburgh Council sent a message earlier this afternoon to all parents and staff in the Craigmount High School community informing us about the early school closure on Tuesday 13 September.

The information that we have is that there will be significant travel disruption along the route of the Queen's coffin on the afternoon of Tuesday 13 September. This will be due to the road closures which Police Scotland are putting in place from 1pm.

As a result, Craigmount High School will close at 12pm to allow pupils and staff time to return home safely before the Police Scotland road closures are in place. You can read the information which the City of Edinburgh Council have provided on the website [here](#).

We will have a very limited catering service for those young people who receive free school meals in the form of a takeaway service which can be collected at 12pm on Tuesday.

There will be work available on class Team pages (or via their year group Teams page in some cases) for Tuesday afternoon.

The school will open again as normal on Wednesday 14 September.
