- The Support for Learning team in Craigmount High School forms part of the integrated Support team which includes six Pupil Support Leaders (Guidance), ensuring students' pastoral and learning needs are supported holistically.
- An Additional Support Need comes from anything that is a barrier to learning. All Education Authorities have legal duties towards students with additional support needs.
