Guide to accessing Class Charts for Parents & Carers



You can access Class Charts through a web browser or by downloading the Class Charts Parents App.

1. Open the Class Charts Parents App or visit www.classcharts.com/parent/login
2. Enter your email address
3. Choose 'I don't have an account yet'
4. Enter and confirm your e-mail address.
5. Enter the parent access code (this is unique Class Charts number sent to you by the school)
5. Choose and confirm a password
6. Click Log-in
7. Once you log in, if you need to, you will be able to add a sibling by selecting the icon in the bottom right corner of the screen.



8. After you select the name of your child, you will see the dashboard with a pie chart and graph which provides an overview of what has been recorded on our Class Charts system by our staff.
9. Under this you will see specific entries in green or red. Sometimes this may be accompanied by a short explanation about the referral, but this is not always required or necessary.

9. When teachers add information to Class Charts, the app will update. There is no set target for teachers to add information- it is as appropriate to the pupil and/or the lesson. Information may be added on the day of a lesson or it may be added on a different day/ time, depending on the teacher's overall timetable.

10. All pupils should know that they are receiving a negative at the time of the referral, through discussion with the teacher. Pupils should also know about positive recognition, although this may be explained in a later lesson, perhaps once marked work has been returned to students.

11. The system is not presently set up for notifications. This means that you need to visit the app or website to see the information.
