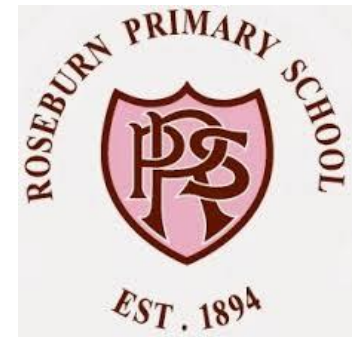

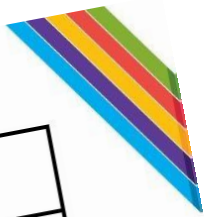

**December 2023** - Closing date for placing requests to non catchment school

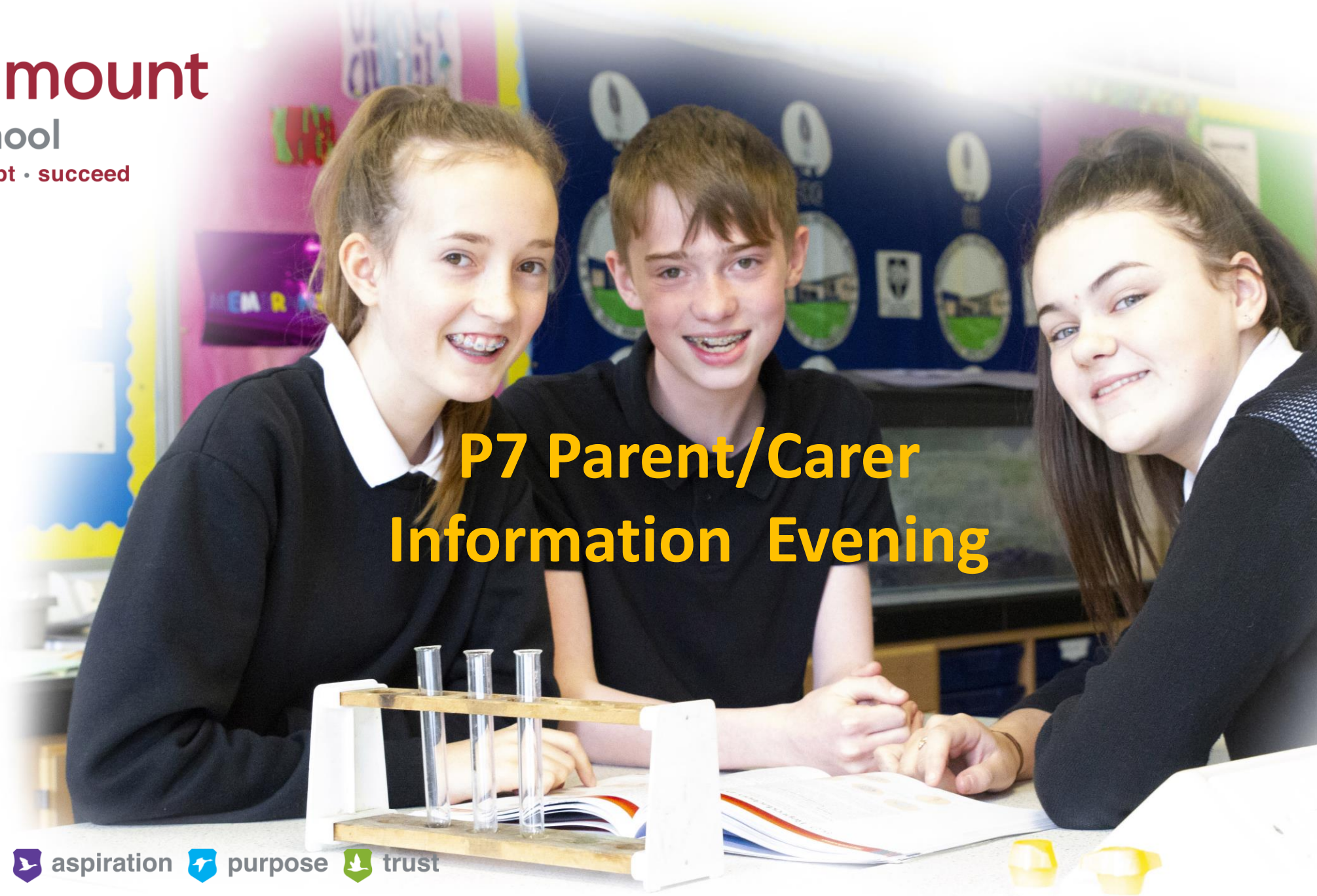
**March 2024** - School Placements post decision letters, provisional allocation finalised
