Key things to consider

- Do I know what each subject involves?
- Am I willing to commit myself to this?
- Do my choices match my career ambitions?
- Am I clear on the future pathways within this subject?
- It's not about your favourite teacher or friendship groupings.
- Challenge yourself and be realistic.

Common Questions

1. Can pupils change courses?

We spend a significant amount of time planning appropriate pathways for our students so changes should not be required unless it is due to an SQA result not being as expected.

2. What if a course is oversubscribed?

Students who have shown poor effort in the subject in S2 may be asked to select an alternative course

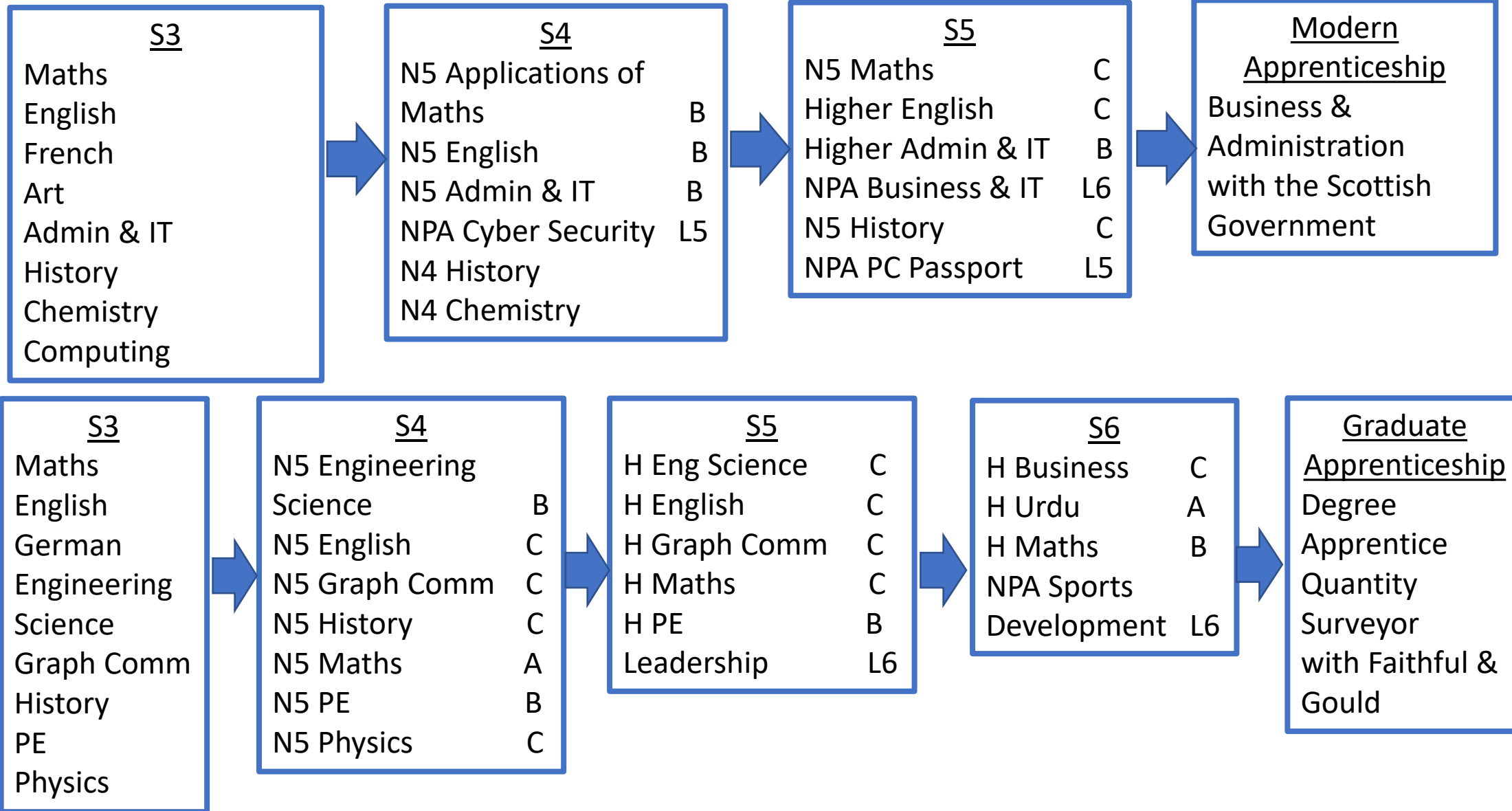
3. What if (s)he chooses a course that doesn't run?

Students will be re-coursed

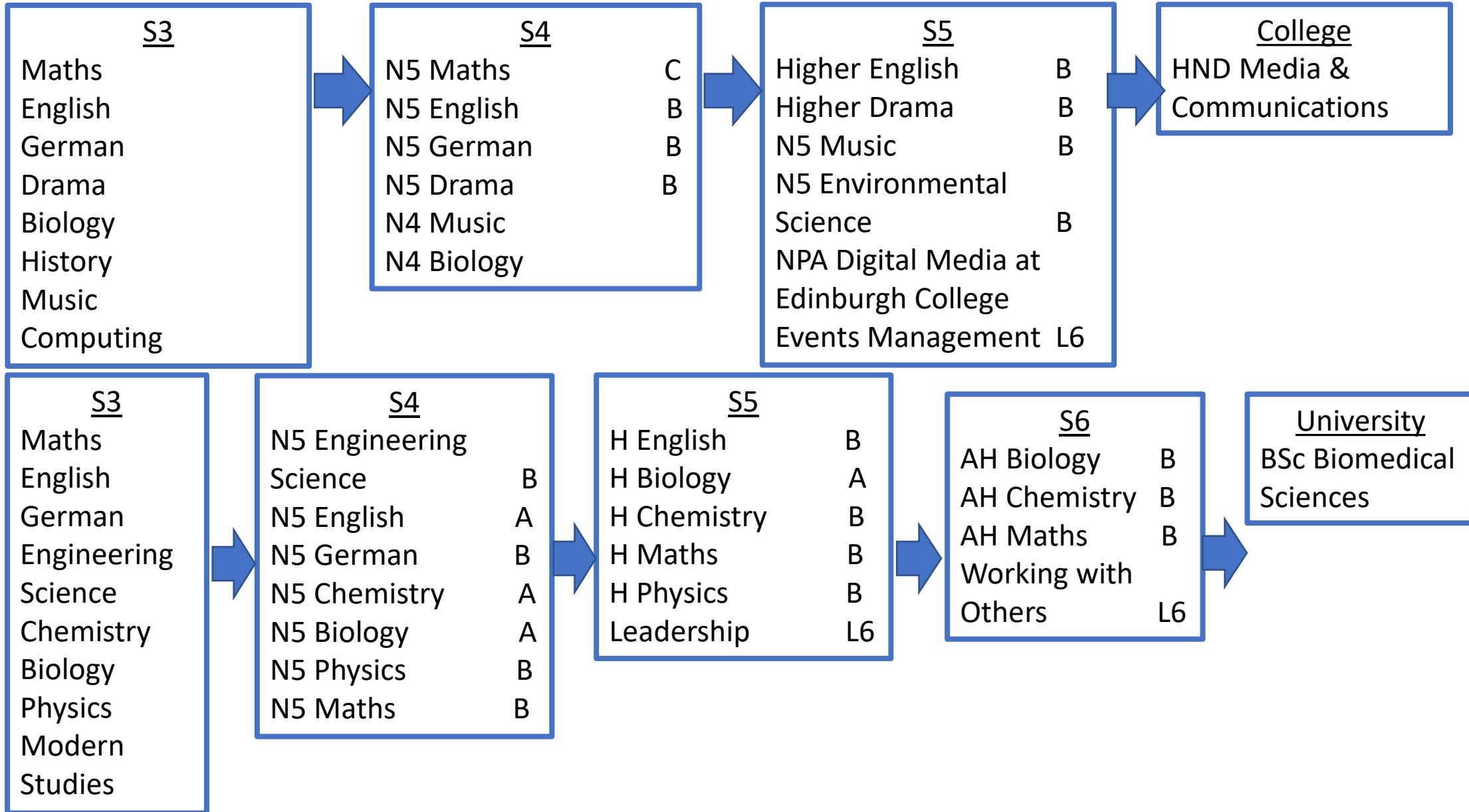
4. What support can we as parents/carers offer?
