If you have a query/concern about your child's progress in a subject or subjects

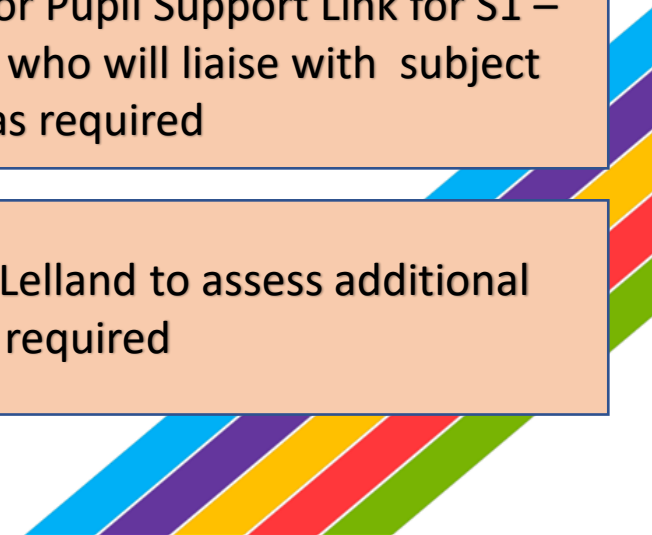

Demerit or Referral made on Seemis.

This may involve an action such as moved seat, change of task etc.

Step 4 Consequence

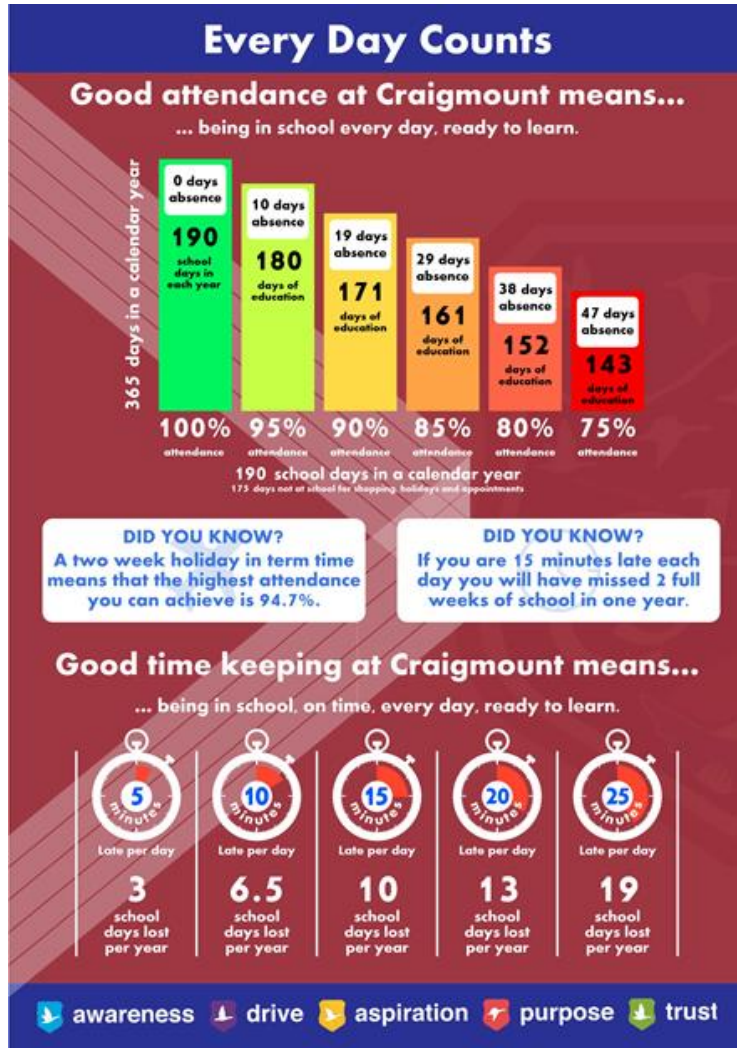
Consequence such as time out, hosting etc.

Step 5 Outcome

Resolution such as restorative meeting, parental contact, monitoring card.
