

Mrs McLachlan had a fireplace at home, and she would send her Christmas wish list up the chimney and run out the back door to watch it burn in the night sky.





CHRISTMAS RECIPES TO IMPROVE YOUR CHRISTMAS!

FILHOSES

Filhoses are Portuguese Christmas treats made from either pumpkin, carrot or apple. Carrot Filhoses are my favourite, and what I'm about to share with you is a top secret family recipe that's been around for years!

INGREDIENTS

- 500g peeled carrots
- 500g sugar
- 500g self raising flour
- 5 eggs
- Juice and grated peel of an orange
- Grated peel of a lemon
- Oil for frying
- Cinnamon sugar to cover



INSTRUCTIONS

- Boil carrots for half an hour until soft, transfer to a bowl and mash
- Add in the rest of the ingredients (sugar, flour, eggs, orange and lemon) and whisk until its
- smooth and bubbly
- Mix sugar and cinnamon together in a bowl and line a plate with kitchen roll
- Heat up plenty of oil in a large pan until hot but not too hot
- Dip two spoons in the oil and use one to scoop up some batter and the other to scrape the
- batter into the oil. You will have to do this in batches, don't overfill the pot!
- The filhoses should turn by themselves if the temperature of the oil is right, if not then
- adjust the temperature and flip them manually with a fork.
- Once golden and cooked through, remove from oil and place on the lined plate.
- Finally, roll them in the cinnamon sugar and enjoy!
