Craigmount High School Extension

I am writing to let you know that we are developing plans to extend Craigmount High School.

The extension project will include reconfiguration of some existing spaces. The purpose of the project is to provide the school with the space and facilities it needs to meet growing demand for places from new housing developments at Maybury and Cammo. The project will also improve and expand the availability of social spaces like the dining area, toilets and circulation routes.

Early feasibility work and discussions with the school leadership team have highlighted a preference for an extension to be built on the grass field at the east side of the school. We will be undertaking engagement with pupils and staff prior to the summer break to inform the development of a detailed design.

If you would like to find out more about this project, give us your views or suggest things we should consider as we develop the design; we will be holding drop-in information sessions at Craigmount High School on **Tuesday, 24 June 2025 from 11:00-14:00 and 17:00-20:00**. We will hold further information sessions after the summer as the design develops and will also be providing regular updates on progress via the school's newsletters and the Parent Council.
